VOLUNTARY NO COST 90-DAY BRAND NAME MEDICATIONS DELIVERED TO YOUR DOOR AT \$0 COPAY – SHIPPED FREE

Information to Share with Members:

NO COST – Your health plan makes this *voluntary importation* program available, providing 90-day supply brand name medications at NO COST to you after at least one prescription is filled through your employer’s health plan in the U.S.

CONVENIENT – Medications are SHIPPED FREE to your door from Canada, UK, Australia or New Zealand.

SAFE – Pharmacies providing the medication meet or exceed all U.S. FDA manufacturing & safety requirements. All medications will arrive in original manufacturer packaging.

EASY SET UP – To get started, simply check the medication lists for both CANARX & ElectRx, to see if you or dependents are using any medication listed.



- BRAND NAME maintenance drugs including oral, topical, inhaled & eye medications
- Oral brand medications provided in 90-day supply in a sealed container directly from the manufacturer
- Contact CANARX via their website or call 866-893-6337
- You can do everything with one call or online, even request CANARX contact your doctor for the prescription
- CANARX will take it from there!
- Prescriptions delivered by mail, directly to your door!



- BRAND NAME maintenance injectables & refrigerated medications, including those for diabetes
- Contact ElectRx via phone at 855-353-2879
- Do everything with one call, even request ElectRx contact your doctor for the prescription. They will take it from there!
- Prescriptions delivered by mail, directly to your door
- Medications requiring refrigeration come in high-quality temperature-controlled containers. Containers must be returned via FedEx with prepaid shipping label included. Drop off at any FedEx location, schedule a FedEx pickup or bring the cooler to the office at work and they can handle the return shipment through FedEx

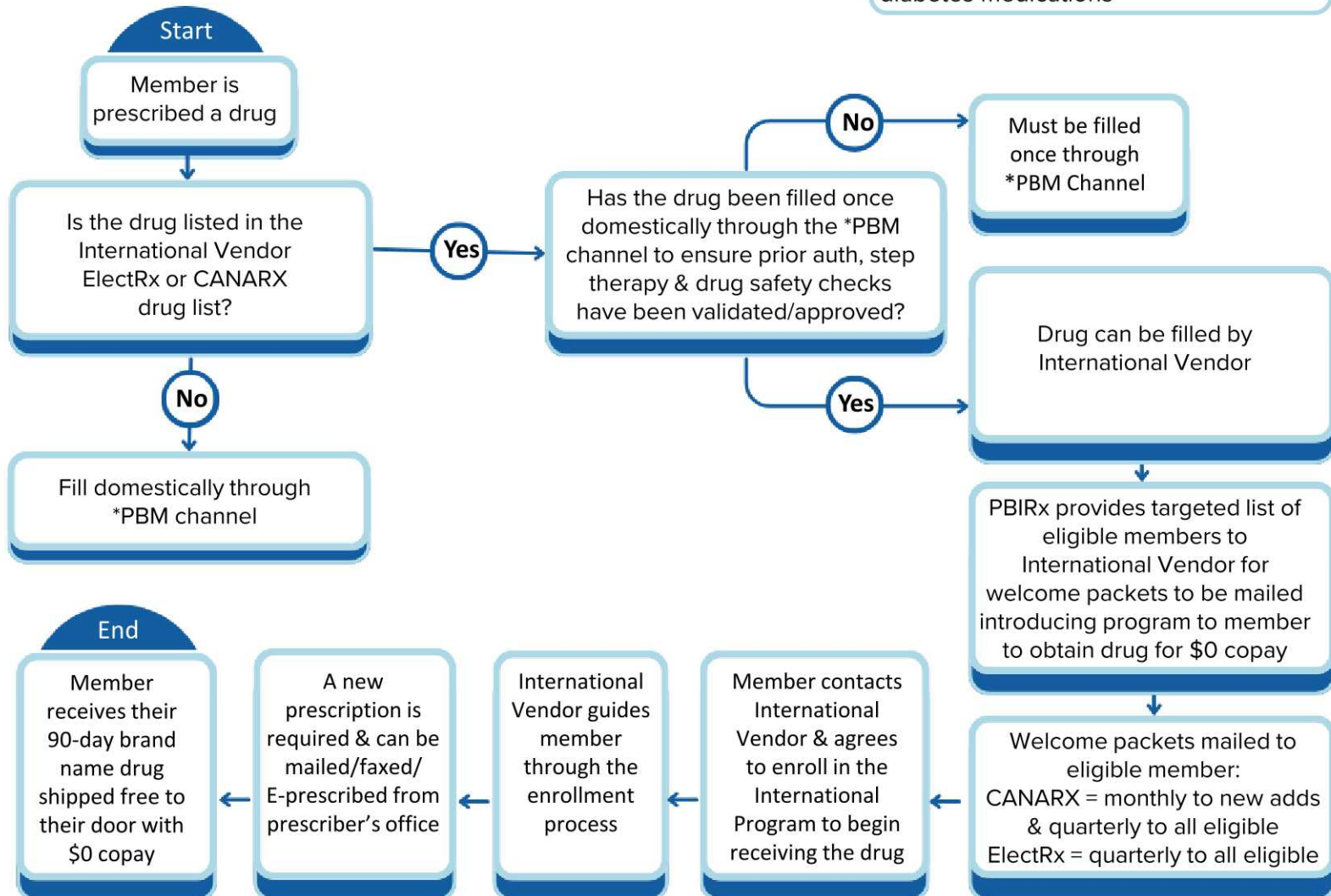
PBIRx International Rx Program

Select Drugs and ProductsSM Program (Paydhealth)

The Plan's Select Drugs and ProductsSM Program allows you to take an active role in helping the Plan reduce your costs, while allowing the Plan to continue to offer generous healthcare benefits to all Participants. The Plan is sponsoring this program at no cost to you. If you are prescribed a prescription drug, product, or service included on the Plan's Select Drugs and ProductsSM List, you must enroll in the Program to comply with your Plan's benefit requirements.

Plan Members Taking Specialty Drugs 1 – 2 – 3

- 1 The Plan's specialty contact center will initiate outreach to you by text message or phone call.
- 2 Complete the digital enrollment application which will allow the Plan's specialty contact center to match you to financial assistance programs that may help you reduce your out-of-pocket costs.

Note: you may be asked to provide household size and income information.

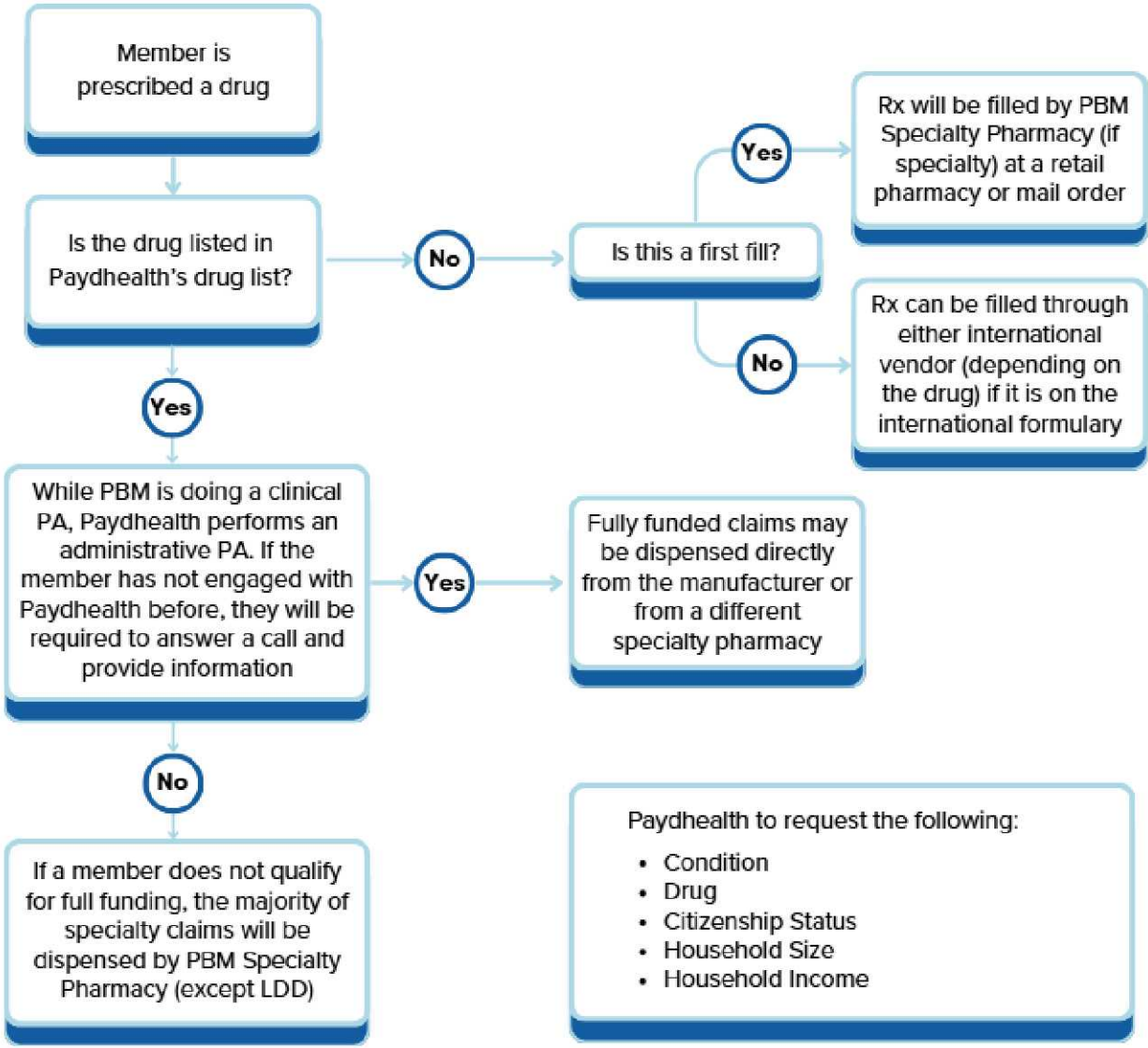
- 3 Your Plan Case Coordinator will coordinate with you and your pharmacy to ensure you are able to get your medication in a timely manner.

A Plan Case Coordinator is available (8:00 am to 8:00 pm CST) to guide you through the enrollment process and the program. Please respond to calls from your Case Coordinator in a timely manner.

How it Works

- RxSavingsPlus for Non-Covered Drugs helps plan members save money on non-covered medications, **including Wegovy**
- The program also provides members with access to Wegovy pricing that is comparable to other direct-to-consumer platforms
- Savings on non-covered medications up to **78% on generics** and up to **38% on brand-name** medication
- The process is seamless, simply present your CVS card
- GoodRx card also can be used for Pet Meds

TrumpRx – Consumer Direct



How it Works

- **Roughly 60 brand name drugs for manufacturers who commit to invest in manufacturing facilities in the U.S. over the next 3 years in return for evading tariffs**
- Government-based discount website for brand-name prescription drugs, mostly weight loss & fertility, showing **cash pay** discounts negotiated with manufacturers on brand-name drugs,
- **Get redirected to manufacturer’s online pharmacy or download coupons**
- **Does not directly sell brand-name drugs**, take insurance, or count towards an individual’s deductible
- Individuals are **not eligible for TrumpRx if enrolled in any government insurance** (Medicare, Medicaid, VA, TRICARE, etc.)
- **Targets the uninsured**, individuals with high-deductible plans, or with medications not covered by insurance
- **No Generics, which, when available, are still the lowest cost option**

Key Differences Between TrumpRx & GoodRx

TrumpRx	GoodRx
Manufacturer-negotiated Most Favored Nation (MFN) cash prices	Negotiated pharmacy cash prices via PBMs & pharmacies
>50 brand-name medications	>20,000+ medications
Manufacturer Direct to Consumer or pharmacy coupon	Local pharmacy (coupon based)
Explicitly designed to bypass PBMs	PBMs used behind the scenes for price negotiation
Often integrated with GoodRx infrastructure	GoodRx pricing engine

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INTERNATIONAL Rx FAQs

Q – How can these medications be offered at such a low cost? A – CANARX & ElectRx source the medications from other countries using a Single Payer Healthcare system which results in lower costs than in the United States.

Q – Are the medications safe? A – Yes! Capsules and tablets are dispensed in the original, sealed manufacturer packaging ensuring safety. (They are not manually counted out and handled as they are in a local pharmacy.) All medications are dispensed from Tier 1 countries such as Canada, United Kingdom, Australia, and New Zealand. Tier 1 countries have the same or higher safety regulations as the United States.

Q – What is the cost to the plan sponsor? A – The plan sponsor pays CANARX & ElectRx for the International Rx cost. PBIRx charges the plan sponsor a percentage of the quarterly savings.

Q – What is PBIRx’s role in helping the plan sponsor with the PBIRx International Rx Program? A – PBIRx helps implement the program. We work with CANARX & ElectRx to create member documents, provide eligibility files and claims files to identify members to receive targeted mailings, reconcile monthly CANARX & ElectRx invoices, provide quarterly savings, and assist with member issues as needed. PBIRx also reviews the medication price lists on a quarterly basis for the plan sponsor, always assuring lowest cost.

Q – What does CANARX & ElectRx do? A – CANARX & ElectRx work with each member directly to enroll them in the program, assist with getting the prescription from their doctor, and manage refills. CANARX & ElectRx provide monthly and quarterly outreach with mailings through the U.S. Postal Service and will call and email members to assist with enrollment upon request.

Q – How are members contacted? A – Members receive postcards and flyers quarterly from CANARX & ElectRx through the U.S. Postal Service. If telephone numbers and email addresses are provided by the plan sponsor, PBIRx will request that phone calls are made and emails are sent, in addition to the postal mailings. All outreach is provided by CANARX & ElectRx.

Q – How do you know if members are enrolled? A – Invoices are sent monthly from CANARX & ElectRx, which contain information about members receiving medication. Monthly utilization reports can also be provided by PBIRx, if requested.

Q – Can members enroll any time, or do they have to wait to receive a mailer or be contacted? A – Members can enroll any time. They do not need to be contacted by CANARX or ElectRx first.

Q – Who is sending the plan sponsor’s invoice? How often? A – CANARX & ElectRx send invoices to the plan sponsor monthly. PBIRx invoices are sent quarterly for the PBIRx administrative fee, which is a percentage of the savings. PBIRx integrates the monthly international Rx cost and fee in the PBIRx plan sponsor monthly Plan Performance Review.

Q – How do I get the Stop Loss Carrier involved? A – PBIRx will contact the plan sponsor Stop loss carrier to explain the International Programs and provide reporting on a schedule requested.
